

# NEW ADMISSION TO B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture/ Forestry& Agriculture, 2021-22 GUIDELINES TO THE STUDENTS

#### A. Admission Requirements:

- 1. Passed Higher Secondary (10+2) with 50% in aggregate of Physics, chemistry, Biology / Mathematics or Agriculture for General & OBC category and 40% marks for SC/ST/Physically handicapped/In service categories.
- 2. The candidate must have attained 16 years of age on 31st August, 2021.

### B. Submit Attested photocopies of the following to the admission committee, CHF

- (i) Pass Certificate for 10+2 Examination
- (ii) Marks sheet of 10+2 Examination
- (iii) Certificate of High School pass Examination in support of date of birth.
- (iv) Migration certificate (Original) from the Board/University where the candidate studied last
- (v) College/School leaving certificate from the authority of the college/school where the candidate studied last
- (vi) Conduct certificate from the Principal of the College/School where the candidate studied last
- (vii) Permanent residency/domicile certificate of concerned state
- (viii) Certificate from competent authority, incase admission is sought under reserved category
- (ix) Medical certificate from a Medical Officer not below the rank of Asst. Surgeon in support of physical fitness of the candidate at the time of reporting to the College.
- (x) Any other documents (as per prospectus/notification) that may be required at the time of admission.
- (xi) Passport size photograph (two) attested by a gazette officer.
- (xii) Stamp size photograph (two) for Identity Card
- (xiii) Certificate indicating the date of holding entrance test, rank of student in the Entrance test and criteria adopted for determination of merit.
- (xiv) The admitted students to submit their Bank Account Nos. and Aadhar Nos. at the time of admission.
- (xv) Anti-Ragging Affidavit
